### What does a student internship at Chil3 involve?

During the first semester interns will undertake a wide variety of tasks (some fun, others less so) and this will depend on the skills of the intern as well as the projects being undertaken in the studio at the time. Chil3 works with a charity every year on a pro bono project and the intern will be responsible for the design and production of this project under the direction of Chil3 designers. The intern will receive weekly feedback and mentoring.

The charity project will carry through to the second semester when the intern will also work on their International Society of Typographic Designers (ISTD) Student Assessment Project and receive weekly feedback and mentoring.

### How do I apply?

The application process involves the submission of an electronic portfolio (pdf) and a statement detailing reasons for applying for the position. Those short listed are interviewed in person and the final candidate chosen.

### How long is the internship?

The Chil3 student internship varies depending on the candidate from one to four days per week, by arrangement, starting in February and finishing in November.

Internships are open to students in their last academic year who will undertake the ISTD Student Assessment and graphic design graduates. Again this is flexible for the right student or graduate.

### What are the selection criteria?

- A passion and enthusiasm for design, especially typographic design.
- A positive attitude.
- A willingness to listen and learn.
- Good skills in InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop.
- Fluency in English.

### What personality traits are suitable?

- Responsive to feedback, direction and constructive criticism.
- Good communication skills and sound organisational skills.
- Polite and approachable manner when liaising with people both internally and externally.
- Being punctual and reliable.

### What are the internship hours?

9.00am – 5.00pm with 1 hour for lunch.

### Where is Chil3?

### Is this a paid position?

Technically, this is a trainee position. At Chil3 we spend a lot of time tutoring and working with our interns and this time takes us away from client work. Therefore this is not a paid position (for one day per week), but the successful applicant will gain real life experience in a busy design practice, receive one-on-one tutoring for the ISTD Student Assessment Project and have access to the comprehensive studio library.
